

THIS IS USED FOR ...


Then, randomly re-distribute the images and the sheets of paper.

Show the drawing and read the utility that it randomly got matched up with out loud.





SEXUALIDAD

In the sessions to come we're going to take a deeper look at the value of sexuality, and try to recognize everything that prevents you from integrating your sexuality and what can help you to do so.

We ask for your collaboration, and request that between now and the next session you can pay attention to information, images, news stories, TV shows, movies, advertisements, etc. that reflect society's vision of SEXUALITY.

I am not called to chaos, but to order.

Things have a purpose and persons are called to an end.

Affections and sexuality also have an end, and I, as a person, am called to live out my affectivity and sexuality in order to reach this end.

If things are not used well:

They BREAK or can cause HARM.

The same thing happens with my affections and my sexuality: if they are not ordered, they can hurt me and tear me apart.

Sexuality would lose its value, and affections would be disordered. We are going to discover how to order them toward their end and acknowledge their profound meaning.
